RELEVANT EXPERIENCE

I have been a psychologist working with the public since October 1987. Bar a 2 ½ year period during my clinical psychology training, this has consistently focused on offenders. I have written hundreds of official reports for clinical purposes, and almost 400 further legal reports for the criminal justice system. In keeping with my academic expertise, these have primarily focussed on mentally disordered offenders, personality disorder, cognitive assessment, fitness to plead, sexual offending, and violent offending. I left the NHS in December 2000, so my clinical assessment role has been exclusively on legal reports since this time. I now typically do 12 reports a year.
